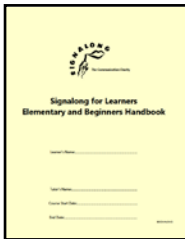

- Uses appropriate methods of assessment

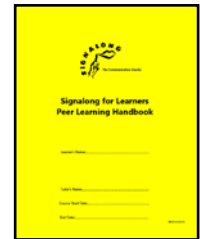
Course Levels

Signalong for Learners courses are offered at;



Elementary course at Pre-Entry level
Beginners One at Entry level 1
Beginners Two at Entry level 2

Peer Learning at Entry level 3



Introductory at Level 1



Intermediate at Level 2

The levels relate to the learning achievement and are set out in the **National Qualifications Framework (NQF)**. Level 1 is defined as below GCSE level, or the equivalent of a D-G grade GCSE.

Learners who have not yet attained Level 1 are described as working at Entry level (either 1, 2 or 3, 1 being the first step). Learners who are not yet working at Entry 1 are described as working at Pre-Entry level and are often people who have additional needs such as learning difficulties and learning disabilities.

Historically, Pre-Entry level courses were excluded from the NQF. However, a government initiative, the Foundation Learning Tier, implemented in 2010/11, include Pre-Entry level achievement within new Entry levels. All courses are delivered by Signalong Foundation Tutors over a period not exceeding 3 years. Candidates will receive a handbook for completion during the course and certificate upon completion.
